After being introduced, the partners tried playing our traditional games



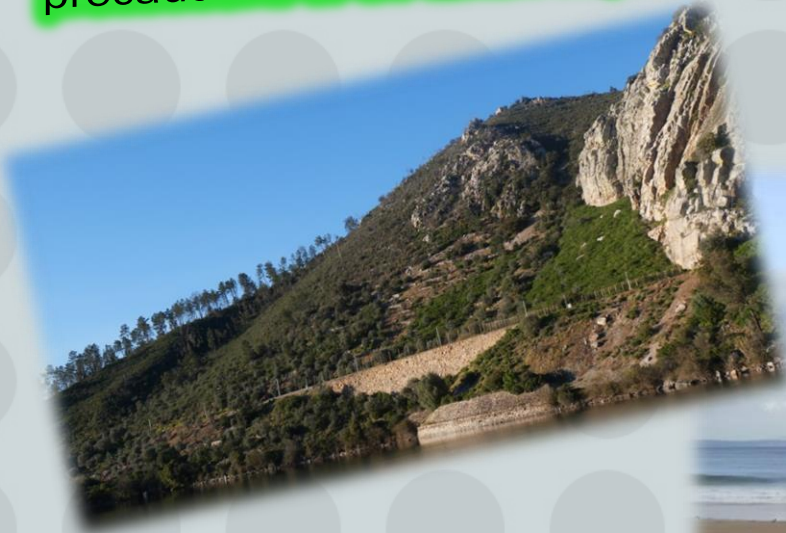
